**A huge thanks** to all who brought stuff, scooped ice cream and the clean up crew. This year's event wouldn't have been a success without your help.

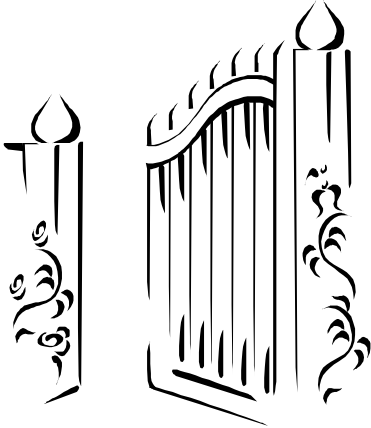
