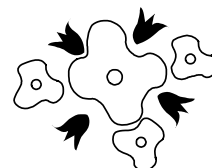
Greetings!


