Hi Neighbors!

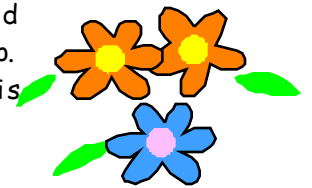
It is so great to have the warm weather back, finally! And with daylight savings time here also, there are more opportunities for us to get out and enjoy it.

Many of you are aware that there is an effort underway to provide some changes to Mourning Dove Road that are intended to control the excessive speeding that occurs along that route. The plan, known as 'Traffic Calming' will involve the installation of traffic circles or 'roundabouts' at the Mourning Dove/Old Deer Trail and the Mourning Dove/Running Cedar intersections, as well as curb bump-outs at various locations along the road. Pool Board Elections

The "pool" board of directors has expressed its apologies to the neighborhood for not being able to hold the election for board members in March as they had hoped. Unfortunately, some residents of Wycombe Manor have continued to state their intention to file a lawsuit against the neighborhood if the election is not conducted according to their interpretation of the governing documents. Because that interpretation differs widely from the legal opinions obtained by the board, the board was forced to once again postpone the election. The board is working hard to resolve this conflict without incurring any additional legal expenses. When the election is finally scheduled, members will receive an official notice of the time and place. The notice will be mailed at least 10 days prior to the election date. If you have already signed a proxy for this election, your proxy will still be valid for the new date. If you have not yet submitted a proxy form for your vote, we encourage you to do that as soon as possible by contacting Sheri Colquitt or Beth Robertson.

On a more positive note, Mike Guerrero and his staff will be back to manage the pool this summer. And the pool is expected to open on time and operate with the same schedule as last year. So if you were hesitating to pay annual dues because of any uncertainty, there's no need to wait.
