Community Watch— Rod Simpkins & Jim Gallagher

The SNNA Board is reviewing its communication plan and looking to streamline activities by comparing the email distribution list to the SNNA directory. This information will also be checked against the SNNA neighborhood map to ensure the email list is reaching everywhere. We need your help.

The email distribution list allows the SNNA board to communicate when SNNA events are occurring and it helps the community watch group keep the neighborhood safe by sharing information as it occurs.

It's not always obvious who some of the email addresses belong to since some addresses are not associated with a name. We suspect that many homes receive multiple emails from us and we ask that only an adult primary email address be confirmed with your street address by replying to this email. It would help if you also tell us the other email addresses that are not primary so we can drop them from our private adult distribution list with no worry. We are concerned that community watch alerts are reaching children since our distribution list is based on the SNNA Swim Team.

Please respond to this email with your name, street address, any other email addresses (that are on this distribution) and your

phone number by **March 30, 2007 (2 months to reply)**.

All confirmed email addresses that are SNNA members and received by the agreed date will be put on a private SNNA-only distribution list. Any email that is confirmed but not a current SNNA member will be put on a list for community watch updates and social event notifications. Any emails that are not confirmed by the agreed date will be deleted at some point. It's ok if you have moved away from the neighborhood and want to be kept informed, just let us know. The private email distribution list will be used for community watch updates and for sharing the contractor list. Please remember that the SNNA board does not share the email list with anyone outside the board and all messages are sent "bbc" to protect your privacy.

Keeping track of how we communicate helps us to continually improve how we operate. Please help us by providing your support.
