You're invited to join over 500 neighborhood families, area businesses, team mascots and surprise guests for our **14th Annual Memorial Day Parade, May 28th**.

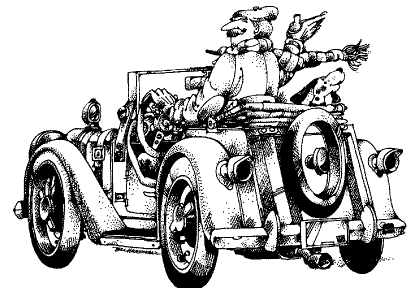
Enjoy it from your lawn chair, or even better, join in! Line up for participants begins at 10:00 am at the corner of Apple Orchard Way and Mourning Dove.
