Annual Board Elections

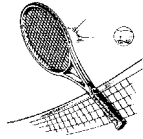

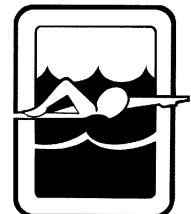
Kathryn Winz and Chris Nystrom were married on Saturday, May 31st at the JC Raulson Arboretum.
