## Mourning Dove Traffic Calming Landscaping Project

SNNA will be meeting with the City of Raleigh to discuss the landscaping to be installed within the new medians and bump-outs of the recently completed traffic calming project. The meeting will take place in October and the new landscaping should be installed by the City in approximately one month. SNNA has worked with the City to overtake full responsibility of long term maintenance of the landscaping.
